STAGE 1 - CLEAN

Using a cleaning detergent



Wash hands with antibacterial soap and water then sanitise with alcohol gel.



Put on disposable PPE and place safety signs.



3 Virucidal Cleaner can be used for the initial cleaning step. Alternatively use a NEUTRAL detergent.



Dilute 60ml to 500ml of water in a trigger spray bottle.



Spray on to cloth and wipe surface to be cleaned.



6 Leave for 30 seconds. Wipe surface with a clean cloth.

STAGE 2 - DISINFECT

Use a product tested to EN14476



Wash hands with antibacterial soap and water then sanitise with alcohol gel.



Put on disposable PPE and place safety signs.
Some infections can become air-borne - Please wear a mask!



Spray surface, leave for 1 minute contact time. If using an alternative product check the label for recommended contact time, then wipe clean.



Place all waste in waste bag.
Seal bag and place in appropriate area for disposal.



Wash hands with antibac soap and then dry with disposable towel.



When dry, alcohol sanitiser can be applied.

Stage 1, can be carried out using a cleaning detergent, followed by a disinfectant.

Stage 2, the example above uses Virucidal Cleaner, which can be used for both stages.
