DELIVERY			
Packaged in 5 litres bottle for use through fully labelled trigger spray.	Risk of spillage if the container is dropped.	Take care not to drop bottles. Ensure that cap is secured at all times.	Transfer bottles to store immediately following delivery. Do not leave bottles in areas where users of the building will come into contact with them.
STORAGE			
Containers must be stored upright in a cool, dry storage area. Product must be kept stored in its original container. Store locked up.	Minimal risk of spillage if spray heads are firmly in place.	Keep bottles in secure storage areas. Restrict access to storage area to authorised personnel. Store locked up.	Use oldest stock first. Make regular checks to ensure that bags are not split or blown/damaged. Make regular checks to ensure that storage area is clean and dry.
USAGE			
Product is ready to use. Spray product directly onto contaminated area.	Risk of eye contact/damage. Risk of skin contact/burns. Risk of ingestion. Risk of inhalation. Risk of spillage on to floor.	Always read the manufacturer's instructions prior to use. Handle the bottles with care. Wear eye protection where there is a risk of splashing. Wash hands before breaks and at the end of work.	Provide employees with PPE as follows: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Respiratory protection • Tightly sealed goggles • Protective gloves Ensure that operatives are aware of location of First Aid facilities and personnel.
DISPOSAL			
Empty containers must be rinsed thoroughly and disposed of as normal waste. Recycle all containers wherever facilities are available. Residual stocks must be disposed of in line with Local Authority Guidelines	Small risk of skin or eye contact. Risk of contamination with other substances.	Ensure that the product is not disposed of via a rainwater sewer (i.e. drain outside the building). Wash out the container using plenty of water. Do not store any other material in the empty container.	Ensure that all operatives wear Personal Protective Equipment at all times during disposal.
