| DELIVERY | | | |
| Packaged ready to use in a metal tin. Tins have screw caps. | Risk of leakage if the container is dropped. Risk of injury to user if dropped. | Trained employees should handle only single containers at any given time. Take care not to drop the containers. Ensure that the lid is secure at all times. Regularly check for any damage to tins. | Transfer containers to store immediately following delivery. Do not leave containers in areas where users of the building will come into contact with them. |
| STORAGE | | | |
| Containers must be stored in a cool, dry, well ventilated storage area away from sources of heat, ignition and direct sunlight. Product must be kept stored in its original container. | Caps are not child proof. | Keep containers in secure storage areas. Restrict access to storage areas to authorised personnel. | Use oldest stock first. Make regular checks to ensure that storage area is clean and tidy. Make regular checks to ensure that containers are not split or rusted. |
| USAGE | | | |
| Product is dispensed from tin onto a polishing cloth and applied directly onto the surface to be cleaned. | Risk of eye contact. Risk of skin contact. Risk of ingestion. Risk of damage to fabrics/clothes. Risk of spillage to floor. | Handle the containers with care. Wear Personal Protective Equipment. Ensure that the container is returned to store when not in use. Always read the manufacturer's instructions prior to use. No smoking. | Provide employees with PPE as follows: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Protective overall Chemical goggles/safety glasses Protective gloves Appropriate respiratory mask When mixing solutions, ensure that operatives add product to water. Ensure that operatives are aware of location of First Aid facilities and personnel. |
| DISPOSAL | | | |
| Empty containers can be disposed of as normal waste. Residual stocks must be disposed of in line with local authority procedures. | Small risk of skin or eye contact. Risk of contamination with other substances. | Ensure that the product is exhausted before disposal. Ensure that the product is not disposed of as normal waste. | Ensure that all operatives wear Personal Protective Equipment at all times during disposal. |
